In accordance with the Detachment 1313 ByLaws, Article 12, Section 1200, the following is submitted for consideration by the body assembled at a Detachment general membership meeting.

Currently Reads:

Section 810 - FISCAL GUIDELINES:

- (a) The Paymaster and the Board of Trustees shall consult with the Judge Advocate or other professionals as necessary from time to time to insure that all expenditures are compliant under the National By-Laws, Department of New Jersey By-Laws and Detachment By-Laws, along with all Federal Tax Codes and all Federal, State and local laws and ordinances.
- (b) The Board of Trustees shall review and approve all proposed expenditures and fund raising income opportunities for recommendation and presentation to the membership for acceptance.

Add Section 810 (c) to read as follows:

- (c) Any motion that exceeds a \$500.00 expenditure of funds must be tabled until the next general membership meeting. The motion must be included in the meeting minutes and notification made to the membership prior to the next meeting where a vote on the motion will take place.

Rationale:

A motion to donate a large sum of money from our Detachment funds should be voted on a majority of the members present at a regular meeting. By tabling a large motion for one month, we are encouraging the membership to attend a meeting and have their voice heard prior to a large expenditure of our funds.
